

COURSE MARKINGS

All yardages are measured to the middle of the green.

Fairway Poles – 150 yards

Fairway Stones: Red – 100 yards; Blue – 200 yards; Yellow – 250 yards Red Flag – Front; White Flag – Middle; Blue Flag – Back

RULES

- USGA Rules apply except where modified by local rules.
- Water Hazards are defined by yellow stakes or lines.
- Drop Areas: On holes 1, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12 and 14, there are drop areas on the green side of the hazard that are available as an additional option under the water hazard rule. One stroke penalty still applies.
- Lateral Water Hazards are defined by red stakes or lines.
- Out of Bounds defined by white stakes and boundary fences.
- Embedded Ball: Anywhere "through the green" a ball which is embedded in its own pitch mark may be lifted without penalty, cleaned and dropped as near as possible to the spot where it lay, not nearer the hole.

COURSE POLICIES

- No alcoholic beverages may be brought on the premises.
- PACE OF PLAY: For the enjoyment of all golfers, groups that cannot maintain their position on the course may be moved forward and/or asked to play the forward tees. A group that continually falls behind may be removed from the course and asked to come back at another time.
- Players stopping for more than 5 minutes at the turn lose their position on the course and will be worked back when space permits at the discretion of the golf shop.
- Leave the course in better condition than you found it. Repair ball marks, rake bunkers, and replace divots.
- Please observe the posted cart rules.
- All golfers must have a set of clubs.
- Play is restricted to the golf course property. Please respect the homeowners and do not enter their private yards.
- Metal spiked shoes are prohibited.
